<u>Directions to Embassy Suites:</u> From I-74 take Exit 95-A (from north), turn right on Main Street <u>OR</u> Exit 95 (from south) turn left on Main Street. From Main Street turn right at first light on to Camp Street which takes you directly to the hotel. *Note: GPS devices give wrong or very in-direct directions to the hotel. We suggest you follow those written here.*

<u>Airport:</u> Greater Peoria Airport 10-15 minutes away, easy drive. Free shuttle bus provided by hotel to and from airport. (Courtesy phone to hotel at the airport.)
