Youth Lease Agreement Rules

1. All Jr exhibitors showing a leased animal at National Shows must have an Ayrshire Breeders Association lease on file.
2. The leasing program is **not available** to youth who concurrently own any Registered Ayrshires either as an individual or in partnership. If the lessee becomes the owner of the leased animal anytime during the year exhibiting, they will qualify for Junior recognition. At that time all lease agreements will be terminated. The Junior member must notify the national office and the registration transfer terminates all leases.
3. A **maximum of two** Registered Ayrshires may be leased by any youth at one time. Animals may be leased by individuals only.
4. The lease may be terminated by either the owner (lessor) or the youth (lessee) by providing written notice to the other party. If the animal has been sold, submitting an application for transfer of ownership will also terminate the lease.
5. Leased animals may only be shown by the lessee (Junior). If a leased animal is shown by an adult, the lease is automatically terminated. The leasing Junior must show the animal at all National Junior shows; no substitutions may be made. The owner may show the animal in the open show.
6. All leases expire on December 31st of the year following the original lease originated, if not terminated prior to that date. A new lease is required each year.
7. The leased animal remains in the original ownership and, if the leased animal is bred, any offspring are named using the owner's prefix. All offspring are also the owners.
8. Lease agreements must be received before August 1st of each year.
